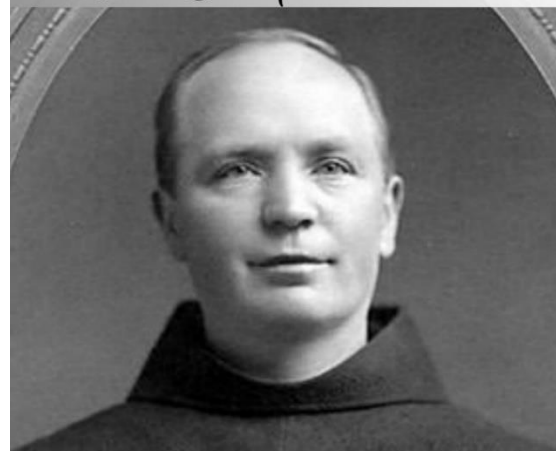

Holy Heroes

St. Leo Heinrichs



Fr. Leo Heinrichs was a Benedictine monk and priest known for his heroic actions during a yellow fever epidemic. Father Heinrichs died a martyr's death on October 19, 1908, in a small town in Oklahoma. He was tragically shot while attempting to administer last rites to a member of his parish. His last act was gathering the spilled Hosts and placing them on the altar before his last breath.
