You, at least, make sure to console me and announce that all those who for five months, on the first Saturdays, go to confession, receive Communion, say five decades of the Rosary and keep me company for 15 minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to Me, I promise to assist them at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls.” Our Lady, December 10, 1925

**Pastoral Letter: Encountering Jesus in the Eucharist:

Part VI – “Five Alive” Practices To Live the Mass

#3 Eucharistic Adoration

St. Manuel González García, a Spanish priest and bishop who was recently canonized, reminds us that “Jesus in our tabernacles is not simply present in the way that a statue would be present, but rather he is present as a real and living Person. Therefore, we are called to respond to him, not just with our physical presence, as though we were a candle or a decorative piece of furniture, but rather we should strive to be present before him with our rational faculties and our entire living being. That is to say, there should be both a corporeal and a spiritual presence. If Jesus is present in the tabernacle with his eyes looking at me, then when I am before him, I should be looking at the sacred Host with my physical eyes as well as with the eyes of my soul — looking into the interior of that Host.” (pg. 37)
