There is information on how to do the Epiphany blessing of your home by the bulletin. With blessed chalk mark the top of your door frame: 20+C+M+B+25

The 2025 at the beginning and end is for the current year. The CMB has a couple meanings. First it is the first letter of each of the three wisemen: Caspar, Melchoir, and Balthasar. It also represents the first letters in the Latin phrase May Christ Bless This House (*Christus Mansionem Benedicat*). Your family may also enjoy making a King Cake for Epiphany...

#### **Galette des Rois** {serves 8}

Ingredients

puff pastry 2 rolls of ready-made pastry 1 cup ground almonds

1 cup ground annon

½ cup Sugar

1 whole egg

1 egg yolk beaten

1/4 unsalted butter at room temperature

A few drops Almond Essence

1 Fève small ceramic figurine or a dried bean

1 Paper Crown

#### Instructions

- 1.Roll out the bottom pastry into thin rounds of approximately 30-35cms diameter onto a baking tray lined with baking paper. Prick it with a fork several times.
- 2.Mix all other ingredients except the extra egg yolk in a mixing bowl, beat till thoroughly mixed and creamy. The paste should be thick.
- 3. Spread the paste over the pastry, leaving an inch at edge
- 4. Paint some beaten egg yolk around the edges as "glue" to help stick the top layer of pastry.
- 5.Place the fève (figurine) somewhere not too near the center.
- 6.Place the 2nd round of pastry over the top and pinch around the edges to stick it firmly closed.
- 7. Prick a few holes and cut a pattern on the top with a knife (if you wish!)
- 8. Paint with the beaten egg yolk to make the pastry beautifully golden.
- 9.Bake at 400°F (fan assisted oven) for approx 25 mins (or until golden, keep an eye on it, all ovens are different).
- 10. Can be served warm or cold.
