

Religious Education Registrations will go out the second week in August. We are planning to have classes for PreK-3rd grade on the second Sunday of each month from after Mass until 11:30am in the months of September – April (with homework graded); and for all 4th -12th grade students from 5:30-7:30pm on (most) Wednesdays from September 11th until Ash Wednesday.

Confirmation and First Eucharist: Dawn will also send out an email asking about those who will be seeking sacramental preparation classes for First Communion or Confirmation. As a reminder, our Parish has a separate program and classes for Sacramental preparation so those who are ready and committed to living the covenantal agreement within these Sacraments of Initiation may have concentrated lessons on this promise they are making to God. Confirmation is open to anyone over the age of reason who is a practicing Catholic. Those preparing for First Communion must be 7 years of age by the time they receive the Sacrament. Classes will be on the 3rd Sunday of each month from September – April. Times will depend on interest. Confirmation is scheduled for Wednesday, May 21st at 6:30pm at St. Mary in Crivitz. Other dates, places, and times are available for those unable to attend this date.



2024 Year of Prayer:

Pope Francis named 2024 the Year of Prayer in anticipation of 2025, which will be a Jubilee Year. This year is a perfect time to form the habit of daily (and even

continual) prayer. St. Paul teaches us, "Train yourself for devotion, for, while physical training is of limited value, devotion is valuable in every respect, since it holds a promise of life both for the present and for the future" (1 Tim 4:7-8). Diocesan Practice for Distribution of Holy Communion Under Both Kinds

Therefore, in keeping with the Liturgical Norms and Directives promulgated and contained within the Church's various liturgical books and documents, and in consideration of the aforementioned liturgical principles, effective on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi), June 2, 2024, the Diocesan Practice of Holy Communion under Both Kinds is that Distribution of Holy Communion from the Cup may only take place and is encouraged on the following liturgical celebrations:

- All the faithful who participate in the Easter Vigil, particularly the newly baptized;
- The Christmas Mass During the Night (Midnight Mass);
- Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord's Supper;
- All weekend Masses on:
 - o Divine Mercy Sunday;
 - o The Solemnity of Pentecost;
 - o The Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity;
 - The Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi);
 - o The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

It is, furthermore, left to the discretion of each Pastor to distribute the Precious Blood to all the faithful present at the following celebrations:

- First Holy Communion (Only First Communicants);
- ➤ Wedding Mass (Only Bride and Groom);
- ➤ The Mass celebrating the patronal feast of each oratory, church, parish, or mission;
- ➤ The anniversary Mass celebrating the dedication of each church.

The intention of this policy is to express in our practice the mind of the Church. It is the hope that these opportunities to receive the Precious Blood of our Savior will deepen the love for the Lord Jesus truly present in the Eucharist.

Thank you to those members of our community who will attend (attended) the August 3rd diocesan training in Crivitz. If there is anyone who would like to be officially commissioned by the bishop for their role as Extraordinary Minister in the parish or to bring the Eucharist to someone who is homebound and were unable to attend this training, contact Fr. Felix or Dawn. There will be another training at a future date in Crivitz specifically for those who would be willing to bring Communion to those who are homebound. Moving forward, one must be commissioned by the bishop to bring Communion to any homebound person (even if related).


