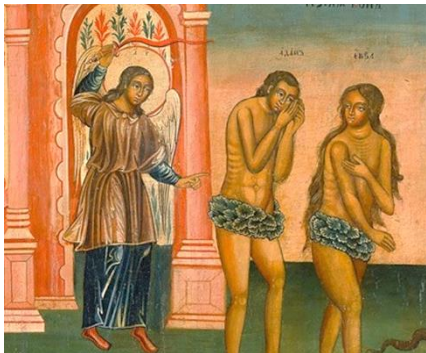

Project priority planning: Representatives from the Green Bay Diocese came to St. Anthony Parish to help us determine projects that we should prioritize as we use the funds from the sale of the old rectory. After hearing their recommendations the finance council, building and ground reps, and hall activity reps got together and were able to identify the top 5 priorities that we will be moving forward with. They are...

1. Expand the parking by the garages with crushed rock for the office, Mass attendance, Karen's Pantry. Includes a path to the office door (about \$4500).
2. Remove and replace cement steps coming from the upper parking lot (install a hand rail on the other steps located closer to the hall.) No estimate
3. Remove and replace the old, clogged, clay pipe storm drain from the east side of the hall emptying to the city storm drain (no estimate yet)
4. Put in rain gutters along the east side of the hall to stop the water coming into the basement bathrooms, stairs, and boiler room. (no estimate yet)
5. Blacktop the area around the bell tower (and maybe even the alleyway - estimate about \$52,000 for both)
