- Before the Church celebrated Christmas, the Annunciation was celebrated on March 25<sup>th</sup>. Then when the decision was made to celebrate Jesus' birthday, December 25<sup>th</sup> was the logical choice.
- The Church celebrates Christmas for 8 days. It is known as the Octave of Christmas. The Octave ends on January 1<sup>st</sup>, when we celebrate the solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (which is a Holy Day of Obligation)
- The Christmas Season ends after we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, which is on January 12<sup>th</sup> this year.
- The idea of the twelve days of Christmas comes from the traditional celebration of the Christmas Season from December 25 until January 6<sup>th</sup>, which was a set feast day of the Epiphany (Three Kings).
