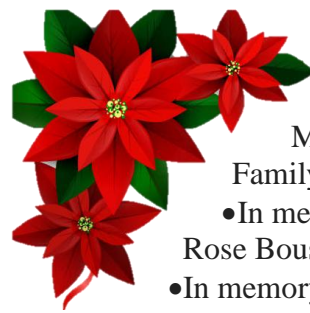


EUCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL is in need of adorers. See the back page for more details.

Did you know...

- Before the Church celebrated Christmas, the Annunciation was celebrated on March 25th. Then when the decision was made to celebrate Jesus' birthday, December 25th was the logical choice.
- The Church celebrates Christmas for 8 days. It is known as the Octave of Christmas. The Octave ends on January 1st, when we celebrate the solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (which is a Holy Day of Obligation)
- The Christmas Season ends after we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, which is on January 12th this year.
- The idea of the twelve days of Christmas comes from the traditional celebration of the Christmas Season from December 25 until January 6th, which was a set feast day of the Epiphany (Three Kings).
